Some new members would be curious on how it all works and despite the Brears' briefing they will learn faster on the job. All looks in place for a successful outcome but we still need more helpers so members were encouraged to find or flush out family or friends to fill out the roster. The new fridges were in place but some eager early members without access keys were forced to sit around and just work up a thirst until John Palamountain turned up with a key. Fingers came about the same time and with help from Charlie Dickman soon had the Bar-B-Cue set up and cooking, More Rotarians began to arrive and it wasn't long before the Kiwi Cook had delicious steaks ready to be eaten. It must be recorded how good they were, in between white fresh rolls, salads and sauces Yum. 3/ Sellers are required to stay within visual range of the Spruikers so they can see when you have sold all your Tickets and have removed your hat, don't stay at an extreme distance from our site as we will loose contact and eventually this can cause a problem.
