## Notes from the Meeting held on the 4th June at the Smith Street Social Pub

Once again we met at the posh night club which used to be called "Roark's" and the eager members were there early perched outside on the adjoining balcony enjoying another perfect dry season evening before answering the call to start on time which we did for Barry's second last stand as our club President.

He called us to stand for the loyal Toast which we did and then visitors were invited to

identify themselves which didn't take long there were only 4 visitors, Steve Gloster our guest speaker, Gary Strachan from last week, Sophie Philip our international travelling student soon bound for Cambridge HK and an ex member of the club Sakib Awan usually a resident of East Timor. Barry welcomed them all to the meeting and got down to announcements starting off with the news that there were now more room for more of us to attend the POOTY Award Ceremony at Government House so if you are keen to go contact the secretary ASAP and you could be lucky. Next week our star attraction will be Dave Pearson's "Me Talk" and although the guide lines say 'Duration 10 minutes' this will not be long enough for Dave as he has an interesting tale to tell. I heard him deliver his me talk many years ago and it was very entertaining so make sure you come for the show. Barry next invited Scott Perkins to introduce more formally our Guest Speaker for the evening, Steve Gloster President of the local RSL and his topic was rebuilding the RSL Clubhouse after the fire which all but destroyed the building. He started off by confusing Scott which he often did as they served together Steve being an army surveyor required to assess what had been achieved and direct the soldiers what to do next, well that's how I understood what went on and how Scott became confused not difficult we agreed. The Main issue was a possible RSL club house perched up on the Esplanade irritating members and supporters of The Deck Chair Cine ma. That seemed unlikely out come as the RSL has only 140 0dd paid up members and not a lot of cash besides with a change in membership make up they really want something that suits younger members with families to amuse and that means sporting grounds and youthful activities inside when it rains etc. Rebuilding at Cavanagh Street is not an attractive alternative and there is the finance factor, many millions to go to the Esplanade or Cavanagh St. Not a cent has been spent only looking at plans, it looks as if the Media got well and truly ahead of this contentious issue and there will need to be a lot discussion and negotiations before anyone makes a move. Ray Fauntleroy (ex military) said the Esplanade near the Cenotaph was a sacred site and that made it a big obstacle for not only the cinema mob, it would cost upwards of \$8million to develop to suit all including the RSL, Dave McHugh had a good idea, why not use the site the old fuel tanks occupy? Nice to hear what's going on first hand and Steve was thanked for coming along and we wish him well with his responsibility, Barry presented him with a Rotary pen presumably to sign up an agreement.

Director's Reports followed, Secretary JP had plenty of information from Papua Niugini and East Timor for those interested. More vacancies at POOTY, Numbers still low for the Change Over dinner. You are requested to make up your minds and indicate intentions so the club can plan for the occasion. Grant Lindsay reminded everyone that the financial year as ending soon so get in quick for tax deductions, and a good time to do it, choose from Polio plus, Shelter Box Australia and many more charities. Ray F is busy putting together 400 bed nets for E/Timor as they are experiencing a Malaria out break at present. It was noted that Grant the turret head did not need the PA system as he described the installation of a vital water pump at the bottom of a mountain providing water for irrigation otherwise a food shortage. One could suppose Rotary had a hand in this project. Ray will continue on with being the assistant Governor for our district and is busy at present arranging the shipment of medical supplies to E/Timor.

We moved onto General Business: Peter Hopton brought us up to date on The Meet the Candidates project, Yes Katie Wolf is still with us as the MC, we are expecting 100 people at the SSS upstairs in the Ball Room so mark your calendar 25<sup>th</sup> June for the start, Peter will brief us on what we do soon as he knows himself! Kevin Wrigley presented the club Banner of the RC of Adelaide.

International Toast was given by Dave Mac for the RC of Vilna in Lithuania, what was he doing over there? They've been going since 2003 and meet on Tuesdays if you happen to be there.

Fingers ran the Sergeant session appointed two nonstop talkers, Eric and Hugh as corporals and got stuck into our depleted pocket money fining members for wearing 'Table Cloth' shirts, Hard of hearing members for not listening to instructions, and other vague transgressions to collect an amazing \$241.90 in fines.

Time was running out so Barry who never cared before about the time anxiously began to wind up the meeting thanking all our visitors for coming and hoping they enjoyed the meeting which I'm sure they did as we certainly did.

Yes, the 2<sup>nd</sup> last meeting under Barry finished at 8PM, right on time!

Attendance was counted to 35(probably included the visitors) officially recorded at 60 % a recent record! Of the non-attendees only 6 failed to apologise. This has been considered as a plus.
